Seattle – On November 14 local wine and food enthusiasts are invited to join *Chihuly Garden and Glass* for VineArts, an evening of wine tastings artfully paired with small plates created by Chef Ivan Szilak and <u>Collections Café</u>. The event, which kicks-off at 6 p.m. in the Glasshouse, will feature wines from Dunham Cellars, DeLille Cellars, Sparkman Cellars, Salida Winery, Sonoris Wines and Two Vintners.

That vintner will be awarded a delicate hand-blown goblet, a nod to one of the oldest forms in glass, created by artist Ryan Staub of Pratt Fine Arts Center, one of the exhibition's community partners.

"Here in the Pacific Northwest we have some of the best winemakers and glassblowers in the country," said Michelle Bufano, executive director at *Chihuly Garden and Glass*. "Vine Arts is a way for us to celebrate both traditions in this beautiful space Dale created for our community. We look forward to this being a new fall tradition."

Following the naming of the People's Choice Award, Betz will host a brief Q&A with the vintners. Party goers can then continue to enjoy music provided by the Brian Nova Trio, meet the vintners and take home a new favorite bottle to toast the holiday season.
